Hopewell Cumberland Presbyterian Church Register, 1823-1934

Background:

Hopewell Cumberland Presbyterian Church was established near the community of Jonesboro in the western part of Jefferson County, Alabama in 1823.

Scope and Content:

This collection contains one bound church register containing minutes of the session and recording the names of communicants, elders, deacons, baptisms and deaths for the period 1823 to 1934. Some of these listings seem to be incomplete, and no marriages are recorded.

The collection also contains a typed abstract listing some communicants.
