ORDINANCE NO. 11-97

BIRMINGHAM CITY CODE SECTION 2-5-72

AMENDMENT TO BIRMINGHAM CITY CODE

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Birmingham, Alabama as follows:

“Section 2-5-72. **Members of library board; term; election; vacancies.**

The library board shall consist of ten (10) members, to be appointed by the city council. The term of office of each of the members of such board appointed by the city council shall be five (5) years. In addition to the members of such board appointed by the city council, the duly elected president of the Friends of Birmingham Public-Jefferson County Free Library, Inc., or any successor to such organization, shall at all times be an advisory nonvoting member of such board by virtue of his office. At the last regular meeting of the city council in each calendar year, successors shall be elected to the members of the library board appointed by the city council whose terms of office expire at the end of such year, such members to serve for five (5) years or until their successors are elected and qualified, and to enter upon their duties at the first meeting of such board in January following. In the event of the death or resignation of any member of the library board appointed by the city council prior to the expiration of his term of service, or other vacancy among the members of such board appointed by the city council, the city council shall proceed forthwith to elect a member of the board, who, in the event of his election to fill a vacancy created by death or resignation, shall serve out such unexpired term, and shall enter upon his duties at the next regular monthly meeting of the board.”
